





A much-loved cultural asset.

The inclusion of a balcony in the design of this 764-seat proscenium arch theatre provides a warm, magical atmosphere popular with performers and audiences alike.

With a full fly tower, excellent technical facilities, spacious dressing rooms and Green Room area makes the theatre suitable for a wide variety of large events. The venue is extensively used for live theatre, major concerts, dance performances, and corporate launches.

Multiple redevelopments have seen grand improvements the The Play House including refurbishment of the auditorium with all seating replaced.

Most recently the theatre received upgraded technical systems including the installation of new digital dimmer racks and lighting outlets, a new Martin PA system with centre and side arrays on power winches, and a new single purchase front loading counterweight flying system, significantly increasing the capacity of each line set.



The lift control system in the forestage orchestra pit features significant safety enhancements. A new mobile Stage Management Console provides talkback, paging and program relay to all backstage areas.







This innovative and flexible space can be used for a range of performances and considers digital trends in theatre production and live experiences, including scenic projection, rigging and audio. Seating up to 550 patrons depending on mode and arrangement, or 850 in 'flat floor gig mode', the space offers a range of formats, including: Traditional end on theatre, boasting balcony and circle levels, Thrust, Traverse and In The Round.

With contemporary, varied and versatile seating layouts, that are also removable to reflect the space's range of uses, The Story House maintains intimacy by removing the typical separation constraints of an auditorium and stagehouse found in a proscenium house, allowing the artistic content to rule.

Specialist stage-lighting, rigging, staging and audio-visual systems infrastructure are provided to quickly transform and bring to life, the theatre in its various formats and to allow



the space to transform and present in many unique and engaging stage / audience formats.

The Story House allows audiences to immerse themselves in new worlds, experience a sense of occasion and ensure the creation of exceptional and extraordinary experiences.







An intimate, flexible, and highly creative contemporary hybrid venue.

This Australian first contemporary and uniquely creative collaboration space lends itself to intimate audience-performer-community experiences and allows for extraordinary versatility where the traditional boundaries defining audience and performer zones are completely dismantled and the space works as one in multiple dimensions.

When not in use for performance, The Open House has the ability to open up and be used for a range of functions, community events, and other opportunities. Seating up to 250 patrons depending on the mode and arrangement, the space offers varied and versatile seating layouts to reflect the range of uses.

A large, motorised door connects the space to the plaza. The space is supported technically by multiple chain hoists on travelling beams and has rigging to facilitate circus style setups. The specialist stage-lighting and audio-visual systems infrastructure is compatible with The Story House.


